Here is a summary list of accomplishments and activities during 2022:

- Granted \$282,000 to arts organizations in 2022 for 2023 productions.
- Added 26 members, 2 Corporate Partners, and 5 Corporate Reps by December 31, 2022.
- Added the Sustainability Task Force to address solutions for long term sustainability for FAB.
- Launched the Spark Campaign Cabinet
- Launched FAB's 20th year of giving and hosted a celebratory gala at the Broward Center.
- Produced FAB's 20th Anniversary Tribute Video honoring FAB's Founders and highlighting 20 years of giving to the arts and a promotional video for "BE THE SPARK" and produced a marketing package to support the campaign.
- Launched "BE THE SPARK" FAB's 20th Anniversary Campaign
- Launched "Legacy Planned Giving to the Arts" Program
- Expanded our FAB outreach to members and the public through social media adding, Instagram, Linked In, and a Youtube Channel.

PRESIDENTS REPORT



This edition of the FAB Impact Report provides the proof of the strength of FAB today as it meets our Vision "Through a diverse, dynamic and engaged membership, Funding Arts Broward will be known as the leading arts ambassador – nurturing, supporting and promoting the arts in our community." **Through the involvement of** FAB's Director of Operations, Kat Sierra, FAB Committees ensure the growth of membership, produce programs that entertain and educate our membership and guests, deliver professional media for both internal and external audiences, orchestrates the grant making process in delivering awards to arts organizations, and manages our financial stability for today and the future.

FAB was founded in 2003 by a group of dedicated women who wanted to make a difference by providing financial support for performing arts organization in our community. FAB celebrated the kick-off of FAB's 20th anniversary on October 18, 2022. At the event we launched FAB 2.0 as the next phase for FAB. With both sustainability as a goal as well as enhancing the FAB's impact on the arts, we launched "BE THE SPARK" campaign. This \$3 million, - 5-year campaign is a **bold** endeavor for FAB. After just 6 months we have already raised \$1.8 **million**. The immediate impact of our current efforts has increased our 2024 grant pool by 30% over last year; - FAB is on its way to reaching our \$1 million endowment at the Community Foundation of Broward. We are so grateful to the over 60 donors that have participated so far, this following the lead gift of \$750,000 from our founder Francis Bishop Good and David Horvitz.

We thank all our FAB members, from our Founders to those of you who recently new to FAB for your generosity and support.

FINANCIALS

In May of 2022, the Board approved changing FAB's year end from a calendar year to a fiscal year ending June 30th. This change allows FAB's financial reporting to better align with FAB's business cycle. Due to the change, FAB's annual financials will be available in August.

FAB members have a lot to be proud of as we celebrate our 20th year of grant making. Eight months into our first fiscal year end June 30th cycle, FAB has accomplished the following thus far:

Initiated the "Be the SPARK! Campaign with a goal to raise \$3M over years. To date, FAB has raised \$1.8M in donations/pledges since launching the campaign this past October.

GRANT Impact - FAB is awarding a record breaking \$385,000 for the 2024 program, exhibition, and art education grant cycle. This represents a 36.5% increase over last year.

GRANT Impact - FAB has seeded the first \$75,000 for a "New Works" program to be instituted by FAB in the coming 2 years.

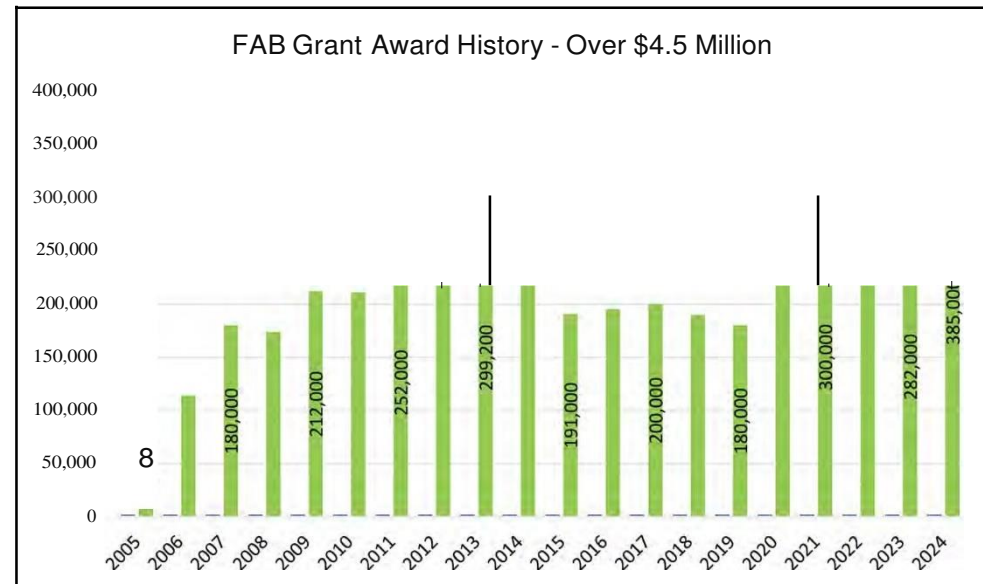
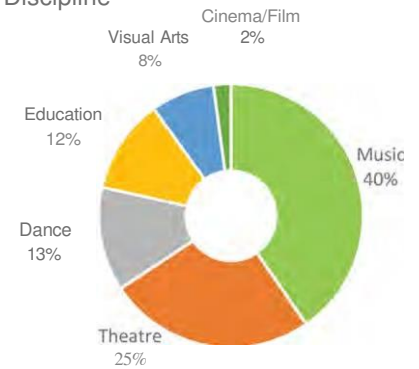
GRANTS Impact - FAB more than doubled the Arts Education Grants year over year.

ENDOWMENT - FAB established an Endowment Fund at the Community Foundation of Broward as a new future revenue stream for FAB grants and operations. To date, it has been funded with \$150,000 with a goal of raising \$1M in 5 years.
